

Android Pay

Setting up Android Pay:

1. If you do not already have the Android Pay app on your phone go to your app store (Google Play) and search for Android Pay and install it.
2. Once installed open your phone's Settings App and make sure NFC is turned on.
3. Open the Android Pay app and follow the setup instructions. (You will need to set up a PIN, pattern, password, or fingerprint screen lock).

Adding a card:

1. Open the Android Pay app.
2. At the bottom right tap +.
3. Tap Add a credit or debit card.
4. Use the camera to capture your card info or enter it manually.
5. If you are asked to verify your card, choose a verification method from the list.
6. Find and enter the verification code.

How to Pay:

1. Wake up and unlock your phone.
2. Hold the back of your phone near the contactless payment terminal.
3. If prompted, choose "Credit" regardless of your type of card.
4. For debit card transactions you may have to enter a PIN. Use the PIN you set up with your Bank.
5. You can pay with your Android phone in stores where you see contactless terminals with either of these logos:



Compatible Devices:

- Any Android NFC-enabled device with Android 4.4 KitKat and above.
